NSA Naples Fire Department Acquires New Fire Trucks

The NSA Naples Fire Department is proud to announce the arrival and official placement in service of two brand-new "European-style" fire apparatus: a state-of-the-art pumper truck and a fully equipped rescue truck. These significant additions to our fleet replace two of our oldest apparatus and represent a \$1.1 million upgrade in our capabilities to ensure the safety of the NSA Naples community.

"These new vehicles represent a considerable investment in the future of our fire department and the safety of the people we serve," stated Fire Chief Kinlaw. "They are equipped with the latest technology

and designed to enhance firefighter safety, provide more effective and efficient emergency services, and reduce downtime for repairs."

These new trucks will deliver significant upgrades to emergency response for the NSA Naples community, primarily by improving firefighter safety and enhancing rescue capabilities. Equipped with the latest safety features, these vehicles are designed to protect our firefighters and minimize risks during critical operations. The addition of the new rescue truck, in particular, expands the team's ability to handle a much wider and more complex range of rescue scenarios.



Off-Base Housing: Security Deposits Transitioning to Electronic Payments

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

At the direction of higher headquarters, Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT), NSA Naples is transitioning to electronic fund transfer (EFT) for off-base housing security deposit to ensure that our personnel living off-base can expect the same processes and standards they would experience at all other DoD bases across the world.

If you're stationed in the Naples area, residing off-base, and paid your security deposit in cash, it will be returned to you electronically and you will pay it back to your landlord electronically. The housing office will contact you to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable our personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

Electronic payment removes a layer of bureaucracy allowing tenants to receive their security deposit directly from the landlord instead of going through NSA Naples housing office. Quick and easy.

Furthermore, electronic payment is more convenient than taking a trip to the ATM to get cash and more secure than carrying cash around. Going electronic will also reduce and/or eliminate the potential for cash drain at installation ATMs.

In the modern era, electronic payments are the preferred method of monetary transactions for every other overseas station and keeps an electronic transaction history, vice dependence on paper payment receipts.

This change ONLY affects tenant personnel residing off-base that have executed private lease agreements through the NSA Naples Housing Service Center (HSC) prior to 10 June 2024.

Your Questions Answered

What if the landlord refuses to return the deposit?

A landlord who fails to return the deposit to a tenant would be subject to immediate removal from the NSA Naples housing program. It is an extremely rare occurrence to see a landlord who fails to return a security deposit back to tenant here in Naples. Per the lease agreement, and in rare instances where security deposit dispute between tenant and landlord cannot be resolved through informal meeting with the housing office, either party will have all remedies available to them under the law. As a DoD personnel, if you are not getting the legal help you need, you should always engage your chain of command to escalate the issue through appropriate channels.

Will the security deposit be returned in Euros?

Deposits are electronically returned in Euros if you provide account information that includes an IBAN number linked to a Euro bank account. If a tenant has a U.S. bank account, they will receive the money in dollars. Most personnel that own a community bank account have reported that it makes security deposit, rent, and bill payments to Italian landlords much easier. Other personnel are known to use the wire transfer service known as Wise. As for the exchange rate, this fluctuates on a daily basis and each tenant may realize a positive or negative difference between transactions depending on when the transaction occurs.

Is it my responsibility to inform my landlord about this policy change?

No. The housing service center will explain the policy change to each landlord.

Radon Awareness: Know the Health Risks of Radon

On-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are in compliance with the Navy Radon Management Program.

Radon can build up to harmful levels in any home or building anywhere in the world.

Radon is a naturally occurring, radioactive gas that is odorless, colorless, and tasteless. Radon gas is released from rocks and soil and can move to air, groundwater, and surface water. It is normally found at very low levels in outdoor air and can be found in water used for cooking and drinking.

Radon can build up in the air in any home or building, whether it has a basement, is sealed or drafty, or is new or old. Take action this month to reduce the risks of radon in your home by opening windows and using fans to circulate air. This increases airflow and mitigates the buildup of radon.

In compliance with the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program (NAVRAMP), NSA Naples on-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are either tested or mitigated or currently being tested.

Personnel that live off-base have entered into a private contract with their landlord, therefore limiting the scope with which the U.S. government may intervene or have control over said contract. However, DoD personnel living off-base can work with their landlord to test for and mitigate radon, if desired, at their own expense.

The lessee may work with the lessor to address any identified issues, as outlined in Section 19 of the NSA Naples housing lease.

While NSA Naples has a known overall potential for elevated radon levels, classifying the installation as a Radon Potential Category (RPC) 1 according to the NAVRAMP, the installation is complying with NAVRAMP testing and mitigation policies at government owned/controlled units.

RPC1 is simply the level assigned when even one unit or building is found on the installation with a radon level over the minimum threshold of 4.0 picocuries per liter (pCi/L).

Demolition of B443 at Capodichino: What You Need to Know

Beginning January 2026, work will commence on the demolition of the exterior structure of Building 443 on Capodichino. This project is expected to continue through the summer of 2026.

Safety First

Exercise caution when driving or walking near the project site. Adhere to all posted signs, which will indicate detours and impacts on parking.

Pedestrian Traffic Detour

Please follow posted detour signs and exercise caution while navigating the area.

Increased Traffic

Expect additional heavy truck traffic on the installation.

Mobile Bar

To ensure continued service during the B443 demolition, the Mobile Bar is temporarily relocated to a new spot near B447. For reference, B447 is located opposite the C4I entrance area. Don't worry, the Mobile Bar will remain open until the new location is ready!

BBQ Pit is In-Service

The BBQ pit near Building B447 is in-service and no further impacts to this location are anticipated.

In-Focus: Food Safety in Naples

Food Inspection On-Base

One of Naples Public Health Evaluation's enduring processes is food safety, which seeks to ensure that food sold at the Commissary on U.S. Naval Support Activity, Naples Support Site is safe to eat and undergoes a rigorous process by the U.S. Army Veterinary Command (VETCOM) who serve as the local food inspectors before entering the store to be sold. The Commissary has labeled the fresh produce to inform shoppers of the area from which the produce is grown. Much of the produce in the Commissary is from Germany and Northern Italy.

Continuous Food Safety Monitoring

Food provided on base is monitored on an ongoing basis. The U.S. Naval Hospital Naples Preventive Medicine routinely inspects all dining facilities on base to ensure that food is properly stored, maintained, and prepared. In accordance with Department of Defense Directive 6400.4, VETCOM ensures inspectors are stationed in the Commissary and consistently monitor food products; all food products are from VETCOM-approved sources that have been inspected; buying from approved sources is required for all meat, dairy, eggs, prepared vegetables and bottled water (fresh produce is exempt in Western Europe); proper facility sanitation; personal hygiene practices of food service workers; and education of food service managers and employees about food safety.

Food Inspections Off-Base

The U.S. Government does not inspect restaurants or supermarkets off-base. Italy has a system in place to inspect Italian food facilities, markets, and suppliers. However, the health and well-being of all personnel and families in Naples is the base's top priority. VETCOM inspects Italian food manufacturing facilities producing food that is supplied to U.S. military installations.

Food Safety Tips

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services provides valuable sanitary practices that can apply wherever you live in the world:

- Wash fresh fruits and vegetables thoroughly with potable water prior to eating or cooking.
- Immune-compromised people should consume only cooked fruits and vegetables.
- Use separate cutting boards, plates and utensils for uncooked and cooked meats to avoid cross-contamination.
- Use a food thermometer to make sure meat is cooked to a safe temperature.
- Refrigerate hot or cold leftover food within two hours of being served. Keep leftovers for three to four days when properly refrigerated.

What Is Naples Public Health Evaluation (NPHE)?

The Naples Public Health Evaluation is a comprehensive study of the health risks associated with potential exposure to chemicals in the environment resulting from the area's waste disposal practices. The Campania region of Italy has experienced numerous challenges associated with trash collection, open burning of uncollected trash and illegal waste disposal practices. In response to health concerns expressed by U.S. Navy personnel in 2007, the Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT) contacted the Navy and Marine Corps Force Health Protection Command (NMCFHPC) to conduct a comprehensive public health evaluation to assess the potential health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Naples area. The NPHE was conducted from January 2008 to June 2011.

What did the Navy learn from NPHE?

Through the Public Health Evaluation, the Navy has been able to identify and address public health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Campania region. The Navy established new health-protective policies and took immediate action to protect the health of U.S. personnel and their families. **Many of these health-protective policies remain in place, as enduring processes, to ensure continued health protection beyond the life of the study.**

Your Health: Facts for Families in Naples About: Food On and Off-Base

The U.S. Navy is committed to ensuring our families are safe while serving our country at home or overseas. The following information is provided as part of a wide-ranging effort to understand the health risks of our personnel and families living in Naples, Italy. A comprehensive Public Health Evaluation was conducted to assess potential short and long-term health risks associated with living in the Naples area (see left panel). In line with our commitment to continually share important health information, we encourage you to review the following information.

In 2007, numerous reports of high dioxin levels and other chemicals in air, water, and soil created a concern amongst the U.S. Navy community that foods grown in the Campania region could be contaminated. Articles in newspapers and in some Italian scientific journals alleged links between adverse health effects and the toxic waste dumps in the Campania region. These articles implicated locally grown vegetables, fruits, and mozzarella di bufala as possibly contaminated foods.


As part of the Navy's overall efforts to be protective of the health of U.S. military and civilian personnel and their families in Naples, the Navy and U.S. Army Veterinary Command (VETCOM) conducted an investigation of foods produced in the Campania region and sold in the Naples Grignano D'Aversa Navy Commissary (Commissary). The food study was performed in February 2008.

VETCOM is the Department of Defense executive agent for food safety and quality assurance and is responsible for providing direct assistance to all DOD agencies requiring support with respect to food safety and food defense.


Although there are multiple layers of health protection already in place for U.S. personnel purchasing food items at the Commissary, the presumed higher potential for environmental contaminants to be present in the Campania region led the Naples Public Health Evaluation team to conduct a food study. The study went beyond routine inspections of food products by performing various laboratory analyses, which are normally not mandated by VETCOM. Foods grown locally, particularly fresh fruits and vegetables, received a closer look.

Using the above criteria, an assessment of the Commissary was conducted. Products that met the food study criteria and were thus evaluated in the study included:

- Artichokes
- Celery
- Spinach
- Cabbage
- Chicken
- Carrots
- Mushrooms

Keeping your Home Mold Free

Mold is more common than many people realize, and it loves to grow in areas with moisture—think around leaks in roofs, windows, and plumbing. It can thrive on everyday building materials like drywall, cardboard, ceiling tiles, and wood. While mold might seem harmless, exposure can cause a variety of health effects, including stuffy noses, wheezing, red or itchy eyes, skin irritation, or even trigger asthma.

Q How to Spot Mold in Your Home

When inspecting your space, keep an eye out for:

- Visible mold, water damage, or persistent dampness
- Evidence of leaks or water intrusion
- Strong musty odors
- Any standing water near foundations or drainage systems

! Controlling Mold Growth

- The good news? Mold can be managed effectively with a few proactive steps:
- Keep humidity levels under control
- Clean and dry areas thoroughly after any plumbing leaks or flooding
- Ensure proper ventilation in showers, laundry, and cooking areas

! Conditions That Encourage Mold

- Mold needs four things to grow:
- A temperature between 40°F and 100°F
- Mold spores (which are everywhere!)
- A nutrient base (most building surfaces have one)
- Moisture

Corners, especially exterior corners, are common mold spots due to poor air circulation, wind exposure, low insulation, and greater surface heat loss.



Tips for using your dehumidifier:



Local Lens: Winter rituals in Campania

January in Campania is a month of quiet rituals. After the holidays fade and the decorations disappear, locals return to habits that feel almost ceremonial — small, repeated gestures that help mark the slowest part of winter.

Days are crisp but often sunny, and locals take advantage of every clear afternoon for a walk. In cities like Naples and Caserta, strolling through historic streets or palace gardens is less about exercise and more about presence. January walks are slower, quieter, and meant to clear the mind after the excess of December.

Epiphany, celebrated on January 6th, closes the festive season. Children wait for "La Befana", a folkloric figure who brings sweets or coal, while families gather one last time before everyday routines resume. Once the Epiphany passes, the tone of the month changes — life becomes more introspective, almost suspended.

January is also a time for cultural rituals. Locals return to theaters, libraries, and small community events, choosing intimate experiences over large gatherings. Evenings are often spent indoors, sharing conversations rather than celebrations, reconnecting with friends in quieter settings. So check your surroundings and finds the perfect chill event nearby.

Beyond the cities, winter rituals take on another rhythm. Inland towns and mountain villages embrace stillness: empty streets, morning fog, and the steady routine of daily life. For many Campanians, a short winter escape to these areas is part of the season — a way to reset before the year fully begins.

January in Campania doesn't announce itself loudly. It settles in through repetition, silence, and simple habits. And it's within these rituals that locals find balance, warmth, and a sense of continuity at the start of the new year.





OCONUS Emergency Travel Assistance Grant

Grant Program for Military Members

INFORMATION UPDATE ON THE ELECTRONIC SOJOURNER'S PERMIT PROCESS

ATTENTION: All current Sojourner's permit holders and first-time applicants to include GS Civilians, DoD Contractors, and all dependents, may be affected by a new processing procedure (NATO SOFA personnel). Note: **Active-duty Service members do not require a Sojourner's Permit**, but please review this information carefully, as it may affect your dependents.


UPDATE: The Italian Ministry of Defense officially removed the requirement for a €16 fee in conjunction with electronic Sojourner Permit applications for NATO SOFA personnel. Therefore, the Naples and Caserta Immigration Offices have restarted processing the new electronic Sojourner Permits for NATO SOFA personnel. Currently, the processing is being conducted on site at the Naples and Caserta Immigration Offices. The potential for on-base processing is still under review. The Naples Immigration Office has reserved Thursday mornings for application processing and fingerprinting; and the Caserta Immigration Office has reserved Tuesday afternoons for application processing and fingerprinting. All appointments at the immigration offices are facilitated by RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Assistance Office for personnel residing in the Naples and Caserta provinces.

What Do You Need To Do Now?

RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Assistance office is collecting first-time and renewal applications.

1. If you have recently submitted your paperwork for a first-time application or a renewal application, you do not need to take further action now. We will notify you via email on the next steps, according to instructions from the immigration office.
2. If you already have a current paper Sojourner's Permit, you do not need to take further action now. You will be contacted by our office when it is time to begin the process to convert it into an electronic permit, according to instructions from the immigration office.
3. If you have a paper Sojourner's Permit that expires between now and February 2026, you must schedule a **renewal request appointment** with the RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Assistance Office by emailing napleslegalassistance@us.navy.mil or calling us at +39 (081) 568-4576 during our normal operating hours. Our Sojourner's Permit specialist will collect the required paperwork for the application, but **you** will hold onto your paper permit until an appointment is scheduled at the appropriate immigration office.

RLSO EURAFCENT will provide further updates as soon as additional information becomes available. Please continue to monitor all Facebook pages and PAO Notes since requirements and information are rapidly changing. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation during this time.






