


Sailors at NSA Naples Take Navy Chief Advancement Exam



Off-Base Housing: Security Deposits Transitioning to Electronic Payments

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

At the direction of higher headquarters, Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT), NSA Naples is transitioning to electronic fund transfer (EFT) for off-base housing security deposit to ensure that our personnel living off-base can expect the same processes and standards they would experience at all other DoD bases across the world.

If you're stationed in the Naples area, residing off-base, and paid your security deposit in cash, it will be returned to you electronically and you will pay it back to your landlord electronically. The housing office will contact you to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable our personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

Electronic payment removes a layer of bureaucracy allowing tenants to receive their security deposit directly from the landlord instead of going through NSA Naples housing office. Quick and easy.

Furthermore, electronic payment is more convenient than taking a trip to the ATM to get cash and more secure than carrying cash around. Going electronic will also reduce and/or eliminate the potential for cash drain at installation ATMs.

In the modern era, electronic payments are the preferred method of monetary transactions for every other overseas station and keeps an electronic transaction history, vice dependence on paper payment receipts.

This change ONLY affects tenant personnel residing off-base that have executed private lease agreements through the NSA Naples Housing Service Center (HSC) prior to 10 June 2024.

Your Questions Answered

What if the landlord refuses to return the deposit?

A landlord who fails to return the deposit to a tenant would be subject to immediate removal from the NSA Naples housing program. It is an extremely rare occurrence to see a landlord who fails to return a security deposit back to tenant here in Naples. Per the lease agreement, and in rare instances where security deposit dispute between tenant and landlord cannot be resolved through informal meeting with the housing office, either party will have all remedies available to them under the law. As a DoD personnel, if you are not getting the legal help you need, you should always engage your chain of command to escalate the issue through appropriate channels.

Will the security deposit be returned in Euros?

Deposits are electronically returned in Euros if you provide account information that includes an IBAN number linked to a Euro bank account. If a tenant has a U.S. bank account, they will receive the money in dollars. Most personnel that own a community bank account have reported that it makes security deposit, rent, and bill payments to Italian landlords much easier. Other personnel are known to use the wire transfer service known as Wise. As for the exchange rate, this fluctuates on a daily basis and each tenant may realize a positive or negative difference between transactions depending on when the transaction occurs.


Is it my responsibility to inform my landlord about this policy change?

No. The housing service center will explain the policy change to each landlord.

Radon Awareness: How Radon Enters Homes

On-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are in compliance with the Navy Radon Management Program.

HOW RADON GETS INTO YOUR HOME

Radon is a naturally occurring, radioactive gas that is odorless, colorless, and tasteless. Radon gas is released from rocks and soil and can move to air, groundwater, and surface water. It is normally found at very low levels in outdoor air and can be found in water used for cooking and drinking.

Radon can build up in the air in any home or building, whether it has a basement, is sealed or drafty, or is new or old. Take action this month to reduce the risks of radon in your home by opening windows and using fans to circulate air. This increases airflow and mitigates the buildup of radon.

In compliance with the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program (NAVRAMP), NSA Naples on-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are either tested or mitigated or currently being tested.

Personnel that live off-base have entered into a private contract with their landlord, therefore limiting the scope with which the U.S. government may intervene or have control over said contract. However, DoD personnel living off-base can work with their landlord to test for and mitigate radon, if desired, at their own expense.

The lessee may work with the lessor to address any identified issues, as outlined in Section 19 of the NSA Naples housing lease.

While NSA Naples has a known overall potential for elevated radon levels, classifying the installation as a Radon Potential Category (RPC) 1 according to the NAVRAMP, the installation is complying with NAVRAMP testing and mitigation policies at government owned/controlled units.

RPC1 is simply the level assigned when even one unit or building is found on the installation with a radon level over the minimum threshold of 4.0 picocuries per liter (pCi/L).

In-Focus: Air Quality in Naples

Checking Air Quality Outdoor

The website hyperlink below provides real-time data on Naples' Air Quality Index (AQI) to help residents understand pollution levels and potential health implications. AQI is a measure of air pollution on a scale where higher numbers indicate poorer air quality. The AQI levels are divided into categories: Good (0-50), Moderate (51-100), Poor (101-200), Unhealthy (201-300), Severe (301-400), and Hazardous (401-500).

The dashboard displays AQI readings across various locations in Naples, showing areas with higher pollution. Additional insights like health recommendations (e.g., wearing masks, using air purifiers) and historical AQI trends are also included, helping residents make informed decisions about outdoor activities. This is not an endorsement of this website, but an effort to keep our community here in Naples informed on the environmental conditions where we live.

Air Quality in Naples – Sources

Vehicle emissions are among the primary contributors to Naples' air pollution. The city's dense traffic and reliance on cars and motorbikes result in high levels of NO₂ and other harmful pollutants that affect air quality, especially during peak travel times.

In addition, less frequent, natural events, like wildfires in Naples, contribute to air pollution and environmental damage.

Addressing these issues requires coordinated efforts between local authorities, industries, and the community to reduce pollution and to mitigate its long-term environmental impacts. It is also important to note the U.S. Naval Hospital Naples does not test or monitor the outdoor air quality across the region.

What Is Naples Public Health Evaluation (NPHE)?

The Naples Public Health Evaluation is a comprehensive study of the health risks associated with potential exposure to chemicals in the environment resulting from the area's waste disposal practices. The Campania region of Italy has experienced numerous challenges associated with trash collection, open burning of uncollected trash and illegal waste disposal practices. In response to health concerns expressed by U.S. Navy personnel in 2007, the Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT) contacted the Navy and Marine Corps Force Health Protection Command (NMCFHPC) to conduct a comprehensive public health evaluation to assess the potential health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Naples area. The NPHE was conducted from January 2008 to June 2011.

What did the Navy learn from NPHE?

Through the Public Health Evaluation, the Navy has been able to identify and address public health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Campania region. The Navy established new health-protective policies and took immediate action to protect the health of U.S. personnel and their families. **Many of these health-protective policies remain in place, as enduring processes, to ensure continued health protection beyond the life of the study.**



NSA Naples Invests Over \$542K in Fitness Upgrades, Boosting Mission Readiness and Troop Morale



Housing Bits

Stove Range Hood Use and Maintenance

- NSA Naples Housing recommends that the cooker hood is switched on before any food is cooked. We also recommend that the appliance is left running for 15 minutes after the food is cooked, in order to thoroughly eliminate all contaminated air. The effective performance of the cooker hood depends on constant maintenance; the anti-grease filter and the active carbon filter both require special attention.
- The anti-grease filter is responsible retaining the grease particles suspended in the air, therefore it is subject to clogging with variable frequency according to the use of the appliance.
 - To prevent the danger of possible fires, at least every 2 months one must wash the anti-grease filters by hand using non-abrasive neutral liquid detergents or in the dishwasher at low temperatures and on short cycles.
 - In the event that acrylic anti-grease filters are used, hand-wash every 2 months, using neutral non-abrasive liquid detergents and replace them after every 6 washes.

Before remounting the anti-grease filters and the generable active charcoal filters, it is important that they are completely dry.

- Clean the hood frequently, both internally and externally, using a cloth dampened with denatured alcohol or neutral liquid detergents that are non abrasive.
- The lighting system is designed for use during cooking and not for the prolonged general lighting of the room. The prolonged use of the lighting system significantly decreases the average duration of the bulbs.
 - Attention: the non compliance with the hood cleaning warnings and with the replacement and cleaning of the filters entails risk of fires. One therefore recommends keeping to the suggested instruction.

Space Heater Safety

Space heaters can be a convenient way to supplement heating in cold environments, but it's crucial to prioritize safety when using them.

- Always ensure that the space heater is placed on a flat, stable surface and kept at least three feet away from any combustible materials such as curtains, furniture, or bedding.
- Never leave a space heater unattended, especially around children or pets.
- It's essential to plug the heater directly into a wall outlet and avoid using extension cords, which can overheat and pose a fire hazard.
- Regularly inspect the heater for any signs of damage or malfunction, and never operate it if the cord or plug is frayed or damaged.
- Always turn off and unplug the heater when not in use, and never use it near water or in damp areas to prevent the risk of electrical shock.

By following these safety precautions, you can enjoy the warmth of a space heater while minimizing the risk of accidents and injuries. For further reference, consult NAVSUPPACT NAPLES INST 11320.2G 9.

Portable Space Heaters

- Portable space heaters must be approved for use by the Public Works Department (PWD) and the FBP per reference (k)
- Portable space heaters will be equipped with a thermostat and tip-over safety shut-off switch.
- Portable space heaters will be located so they cannot be easily overturned.
- Portable space heaters will be plugged directly into a wall receptacle.
- The area around the heater will be kept clear of all combustible materials.
- Portable space heaters will be used in such a manner as not to create an overload of the circuit or device.
- Portable Space heaters will be un-plugged when not in use.
- Portable space heaters must meet all safety requirements of Underwriter Laboratories (UL), Factory Mutual (FM) or European CE. Each unit must have a marking indicating one of these labels.

PCS: How to Terminate Your Lease on the Economy

Preparing for your PCS move out of NSA Naples requires careful planning and adherence to specific steps. Begin by initiating preparations at least 45 days in advance by contacting the housing service center. We will set up an appointment to terminate your lease. You MUST give your landlord 30 days' notice to terminate the lease. The housing counselor will also arrange for loaner furniture to be delivered and picked up at that appointment. At some point you will schedule a final clearance with your landlord. You are entitled to furniture for up to 90 days. Prior to moving out be sure to shut off your electric thru the NEX or JFC effective your vacate date. It is essential to stay on top of these tasks to ensure a smooth transition during your PCS move from NSA Naples.

PCS: How to Terminate Your in Base Housing

It is important to know that if you are leaving base housing for any reason, including PCS you are required to give 30 day notice and you must contact the assignment office to schedule an appointment to do an intent to vacate.

1st Appointment at Housing Service center

- The Assignment office is located at the Support Site Facility Building 2072 and is open Monday through Friday, from 7:45: a.m. Until 3:45p.m. Contact the office at DSN 629-4930 to schedule your first appointment.
- Bring a copy of your PCS orders to this first appointment. You will complete an "Intent to Vacate" notice and schedule your preliminary and final inspections. The Assignment Counselor will arrange for loaner furniture to be delivered and picked up.

2nd Appointment at your Apartment

- During the pre-inspection of your home, the Housing representative will inform you of what will be expected at the final checkout, as well as take notes of needed repairs. During the pre- inspection, be sure to ask any questions you may have concerning items that have been lost or damaged. This inspection will take approximately 60 minutes.
- Please make arrangements to keep this pre-inspection appointment. Missing the appointment will slow up the vacating process.

3rd Appointment at your Apartment

- You must have a final inspection of your home in order to complete your requirements for vacating government quarters before PCSing. To complete the final inspection it is important to have all personal property removed prior to your scheduled appointment.
- At the final inspection a Housing representative will examine the residence in the following areas: condition and cleanliness of quarters; and inventory, condition and cleanliness of government equipment, appliances and loaner furniture. During the final inspection, you will sign a memorandum indicating the date that you passed your final inspection and vacated quarters.
- Following your final inspection you will need to report to the Assignment Office for your final BAH and signature of the check-out sheet



February in Campania marks a subtle shift in energy. Winter is still present, but something lighter begins to surface. Colors return, laughter gets louder, and the streets slowly fill again. This is Carnival season, and for locals, it's less about spectacle and more about tradition, community, and shared joy.

After mid-February, towns across the region come alive with parades, masks, and music. In places like Saviano, large allegorical floats built by local groups take over the streets, turning craftsmanship and satire into a collective celebration. Along the coast, towns such as Maiori blend Carnival with the sea, transforming promenades into vibrant stages where locals and visitors mix freely.

But Carnival in Campania isn't only about big events. In smaller towns Marcianise, Capua, Putignano and others between Caserta and Naples, celebrations feel more intimate but not less spectacular: neighborhood parades, children in handmade costumes, music echoing through narrow streets. Locals gather in piazzas not just to watch, but to participate and to watch the unique parade floats with the sound of the "bottari". Bottari are something truly amazing and unique, making music out of farm equipment while parading around the city.

For Campanians, Carnival is one last burst of color before winter fades. It's a time to step outside, wear a mask, and reconnect with the community. And if you're here after mid-February, all it takes is following the sound of music to find yourself in the middle of it.

Gricignano di Aversa Gears Up for Carnival: A Month of Festivities for the NSA Naples Community

The town of Gricignano di Aversa, Italy is set to host its annual Carnival, a month-long celebration of parades, shows, and family fun throughout February 2026. For U.S. service members, civilian personnel and their families at the nearby U.S. Naval Support Activity (NSA) Naples Support Site, this festival offers a unique opportunity to experience local Italian culture.

The festivities are a community-wide effort, organized by local associations to provide entertainment for all ages. The centerpiece of the carnival will be a series of large-scale parades, with major processions scheduled for Sunday, February 1st, and Sunday, February 15th.

A special family-focused festival is planned for Sunday, February 8th. The events will take place in Piazzetta Sole, a short distance from the Support Site, and will feature inflatables, street performers, and various entertainers to delight children and adults alike, starting at 3:30 p.m.

On Tuesday, February 17th, the carnival will reach its grand finale on "Fat Tuesday," known in Italy as Martedì Grasso. The name is derived from the tradition of eating rich, fatty foods to use them up before the Lenten fast begins on Ash Wednesday.

The day's events will begin at 10:00 AM with a new parade along Via Sant'Antonio Abate and Corso Umberto I, with an expected arrival at the Mazzoni public park at 12:00 PM. Later, starting at 4:00 PM, the Mazzoni public park will host the final party, featuring entertainment and street food dedicated to local gastronomic specialties. At 7:00 PM, the Gricignanese Carnival lottery will be drawn, followed by the grand finale at 7:30 PM: "The Best 90's" show, starring showman Raffaele Assante, which will feature nineties music.

The Gricignano di Aversa Carnival presents a wonderful occasion for the NSA Naples community to engage with their Italian hosts, build stronger community ties, and create lasting memories. All personnel and their families are encouraged to take part in the celebrations.





Grant Program for Military Members

INFORMATION UPDATE ON THE ELECTRONIC SOJOURNER'S PERMIT PROCESS

ATTENTION: All current Sojourner's permit holders and first-time applicants to include GS Civilians, DoD Contractors, and all dependents, may be affected by a new processing procedure (NATO SOFA personnel). Note: **Active-duty Service members do not require a Sojourner's Permit**, but please review this information carefully, as it may affect your dependents.


UPDATE: The Italian Ministry of Defense officially removed the requirement for a €16 fee in conjunction with electronic Sojourner Permit applications for NATO SOFA personnel. Therefore, the Naples and Caserta Immigration Offices have restarted processing the new electronic Sojourner Permits for NATO SOFA personnel. Currently, the processing is being conducted on site at the Naples and Caserta Immigration Offices. The potential for on-base processing is still under review. The Naples Immigration Office has reserved Thursday mornings for application processing and fingerprinting; and the Caserta Immigration Office has reserved Tuesday afternoons for application processing and fingerprinting. All appointments at the immigration offices are facilitated by RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Assistance Office for personnel residing in the Naples and Caserta provinces.

What Do You Need To Do Now?

RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Assistance office is collecting first-time and renewal applications.

1. If you have recently submitted your paperwork for a first-time application or a renewal application, you do not need to take further action now. We will notify you via email on the next steps, according to instructions from the immigration office.
2. If you already have a current paper Sojourner's Permit, you do not need to take further action now. You will be contacted by our office when it is time to begin the process to convert it into an electronic permit, according to instructions from the immigration office.
3. If you have a paper Sojourner's Permit that expires between now and February 2026, you must schedule a **renewal request appointment** with the RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Assistance Office by emailing napleslegalassistance@us.navy.mil or calling us at +39 (081) 568-4576 during our normal operating hours. Our Sojourner's Permit specialist will collect the required paperwork for the application, but **you** will hold onto your paper permit until an appointment is scheduled at the appropriate immigration office.

RLSO EURAFCENT will provide further updates as soon as additional information becomes available. Please continue to monitor all Facebook pages and PAO Notes since requirements and information are rapidly changing. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation during this time.



Where does the Commissary get its meat products?

Shoppers are amazed to learn that the USDA-approved Natural and Choice beef we sell in the commissaries in Europe and the Middle East are shipped here from the U.S. Even more surprising, is that the retail cuts of beef are fresh, never frozen. This is accomplished through the use of vacuum packaging.

What are the advantages of vacuum packaging?

- Because oxygen is removed, the shelf life of vacuum-packaged red meat increases from a matter of days to at least two weeks.
- Vacuum packaging allows natural enzymes to act as a natural tenderizer and enhances quality/palatability of beef.
- Without the vacuum technology, most locations would have only frozen meat products.



Beef gets its red color from exposure to oxygen. In our vacuum packing process, we remove over 99% of the oxygen from the package. The lack of oxygen turns the meat a darker color but the meat will return back to the usual red-color once the package is opened and is, once again, exposed to oxygen.

The vacuum package does not allow for any air in or out. This can cause naturally occurring lactic acid to build up inside the package. Shortly after opening the package, the initial off-odor will dissipate.

This process does not affect the quality of the meat or taste and acts as a natural meat tenderizer.

The Central Meat Processing Plant's state-of-the-art facility features highly efficient meat processing and vacuum machines, metal detectors and X-ray machines, a flash freezer, and high-tech cleaning systems. USDA Beef is cut, ground, packaged, vacuum sealed, and shipped from Kaiserslautern Cold Storage to our overseas locations. Fresh pork is sourced locally from German locations and processed under the same strict guidelines. Commissaries receive shipments an average of every two to three days, depending on the size and sales volume of the location.

Just as you can go to a stateside commissary and place a special order for pork or beef, you can do the same here in Europe. You can simply request a special order from the commissary at the meat department or front-end department by filling out a special-order form if you are looking for a large quantity or a special cut.

Special order lead times vary depending on the request but a majority can be filled within days. Large quantity requests may take up to eight weeks. Whole pigs require a 10-day lead time. Check with your commissary for details.


