MO tornado drill

The National Weather Service reports 16 Missourians died because of tornadoes in 2025, making it the deadliest year for tornadoes in the state since 158 people were killed in the Joplin EF-5 tornado in 2011. During [Missouri Severe Weather Preparedness Week](#), March 2 to 6, a statewide tornado drill will be held at 11 a.m. on Wednesday, March 4. Outdoor warning sirens will sound across participating Missouri communities. Participants should practice taking cover in a designated shelter area or an interior room on the lowest level of a secure structure.
