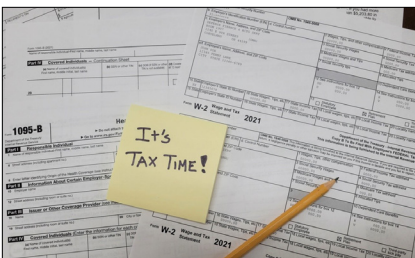
CBRN, engineer trainees sharpen needed skills, build synergy during student-led event

Service members have options leading up to Tax Day

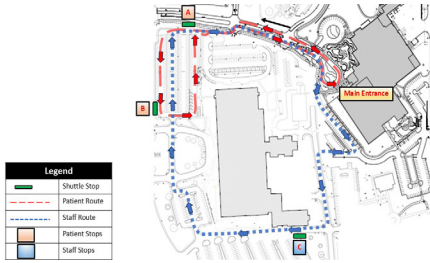
