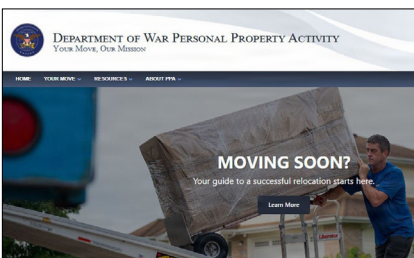
Fort Leonard Wood to validate emergency response protocols, installation readiness

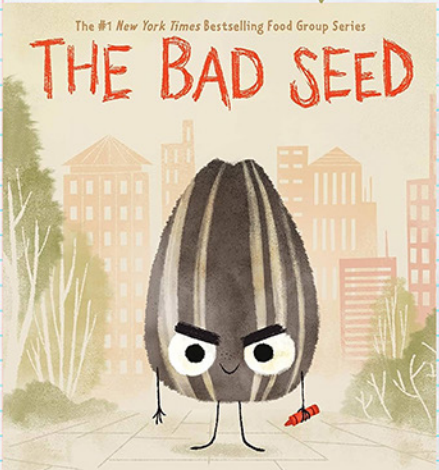
