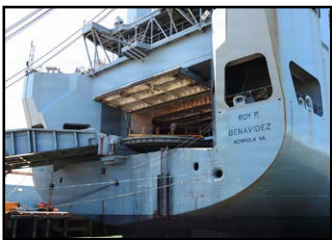
Army gives OIB Transformation update on Capitol Hill

Two-phase project to expand radar campus at TYAD

TOBYHANNA, Pa. – Tobyhanna Army Depot is leveling up its radar testing campus. The first phase of this proposed two-phase project will create additional capacity through the extension of an existing ridge, expansion of a current building, and the creation of new radomes and testing pads. Phase two will increase capabilities through the building of an off-site tower to improve calibration accuracy.
